About PSI Day Habilitation Program

PSI prepares adults for community integration and increased self sufficiency. PSI staff helps the individual develop life skills, and the self confidence to function as independently as possible in the community. All services are individualized, designed to help individuals realize their personal goals.

PSI Employment Readiness Program Offers...

Comprehensive Assessments

PSI interdisciplinary team interviews individuals and caregivers to determine their personal goals and complete the Adaptive Living Skills assessments.

Individual Plans of Care

PSI interdisciplinary team prepares a comprehensive plan with a focus on life skills and community integration activities.

Community Integration Activities

PSI plans and implements activities in the community daily. Activities planned are based on consumer choice and are designed to meet the goals outlined in the ISP.

Social Skills Training

Appropriate social skills training is an integral part of the program. The goal is to teach individuals to be socially appropriate at home, in the community and at work.

Life Skills Training

Life Skills Training is offered to help facilitate the individuals ability to integrate into the community and to function as independently as possible.
